

AUTUMN CROCUS GROWING GUIDE



COMMON NAME Rain Lily Zephyranthes candida

PLANTING TIME Autumn to spring

DEPTH2.5 - 5cm deep WIDTH 8 - 10cm HEIGHT 15-20 cm

POSITION Grows best in full sun to partial shade.

WATERING Rain Lilies rely on occasional summer/autumn watering or natural heavy rainfall to initiate flowering.

FERTILISING Decayed manure or compost dug into soil well before planting will improve growth. Supplementary fertilizer is not essential but a scattering of complete plant food may be given in spring.

LIFTING AND STORAGE Generally, best left undisturbed. May take a season to settle in and flower again.

PESTS Highly pest and disease resistant.

TIPS Generally frost hardy, but can be damaged when temperatures reach 0 to -5C. Drought hardy Rain Lily's love warm locations with ample summer watering or rainfall.
