

HYACINTH KIT INSTRUCTIONS



Common Name: HYACINTH

Botanical Name: Hyacinthus orientalis

- 1. Place Bulb in Crisper tray of fridge for 4-6 weeks.
- 2. Place Charcoal in bottom of vase then fill vase with water, making sure the bottom of the bulb doesn't touch the bottom of the bulb.
- 3. Place the vase in a dark, cool, ventilated spot, checking that the water level remains just below the bulb.
- 4. At approx. 10-12 weeks the bulb should begin to shoot, once it is 50mm tall and there is roots appearing, bring the vase into a room where there is light and the temperature is around the 15-20 degrees. This will encourage the hyacinth to bloom.
- 5. It is recommended that you introduce the bulb to the new light conditions slowly over a few days, this prevents the flower from growing open and elongated.
- 6. To maximise the flowering time, don't place the vase to close to any heat source as this will cause the flower to open quickly and die.
